<u>CIRCULAR NO: 29/2024</u> <u>Circular for Participation in Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM) Online Exam</u>

Dear Parents,

Greetings from Birla Public School, Kishangarh!!!

VIDYARTHI VIGYAN MANTHAN (VVM) is an initiative of Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA) in collaboration with the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), an institution under the Ministry of Education, Government of India, and the National Council of Science Museums (NCSM), an autonomous organization under the Ministry of Culture, Government of India. VVM is a national program aimed at popularizing science among school students.

Attached to this email is the list of students (Grade VI to XI) who are registered for the VVM Exam. These students are already familiar with the exam instructions, having completed a Mock Test in October.

No student will be allowed to log in before 10:00 AM or after 06:00 PM. Each student can log in only once on October 27th, 2024.

Details about Level 1 Examination:

The examination will consist of a single session lasting one hour and thirty minutes at the School Level (Level 1), featuring 100 multiple-choice questions, each worth one mark. The examination will comprise two segments: Section A (40 questions from the study material "Indian Contributions to Science" and the life story of Dr. Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar, to be provided by Vijnana Bharati) and Section B (60 questions based on NCERT textbooks and various State Boards' curricula, along with Logic and Reasoning materials). For detailed syllabus information, please refer to the VVM website.

Student evaluation will be based on their individual performance at each level. The examination will be conducted in English, Hindi, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Gujarati, Punjabi, Bengali, Odia, Assamese, Sanskrit, and Urdu (major regional languages).

Note:

• Answers in Section B will only be evaluated if a student secures 50% or more (i.e., at least 20 marks) in Section A. The final merit list for identifying participants for the State Level Camp will be based on total marks scored in both sections. In the event of a tie, marks obtained in Section A will serve as the tiebreaker.

• Students' scores will be available on their dashboard after the results are declared. They can log in to their VVM account to check their scores and download participation or merit certificates.

Final Examination:

Three days before the exam date, students will receive an SMS and email notification to download the latest App. The VVM Exam App can be downloaded from this given link- apk file, will be available for all students appearing for the examination on October 27th, 2024. Students can log in to the Exam App any time from 10:00 AM to 06:00 PM to take the exam using an Android device (minimum supported Android version is 5.0).

This App will verify the following:

a) Student login details -

Username- Enter registered mail id and password- vvm2024.

- b) Connection speed and provide a warning if the speed falls below the threshold.
- c) Verify the Exam App ID to ensure the student is using the latest version.
- d) After successful verification, students will select their preferred medium for the exam and download the question paper (in encrypted format). This option will be available within the Exam App.
- e) Students must click the "Go to Exam" button in the Exam App to begin. f) Instructions will be displayed on the first page; students are requested to read them carefully and click the "I Agree" button at the end to start the exam.
- g) Once the submission is complete, students will receive a notification and will not be able to retake the exam.
- h) After the exam time has ended, students need to upload their answer sheets via one of three options: 1) Upload Answer Sheet, 2) Upload File, and 3) Send Email (an auto-drafted email will be provided, requiring only a click to send). In case of connection failure, the application will save answers automatically in an encrypted format, allowing students to upload their answer sheets within the provided time frame.
