

CARBER COUSSELLING WEEK















Birla Public School, Kishangarh, hosted the Silver Zone International Olympiad in three categories during November 2024. Silver Zone International English Olympiad was held on 12th November, followed by International Science Olympiad on 13th November, and International Reasoning and Aptitude Olympiad on 16th November. These Olympiads provided students with a platform to showcase their skills and compete at an international level in their respective fields.

In the series, Silver Zone International Social Studies Olympiad was held on 5th December 2024 at Birla Public School, Kishangarh. Students from Classes VI to XII participated enthusiastically, showcasing their knowledge and competitive spirit. The event aimed to enhance students' understanding of social studies through a global platform.

Silver Zone Olympiad Result

A total of 44 students from Grades V to XII participated in Silver Zone Science Olympiad, Smart Kid G.K. Olympiad, and International English Olympiad (IEO). Across these competitions, students secured 15 Gold medals and 11 Silver medals. In Silver Zone Science Olympiad, 14 students participated, winning 6 Gold, 4 Silver, and 4 Bronze medals. Monil Moondra (Grade X) qualified for Level 2. The Smart Kid G.K. Olympiad witnessed outstanding performances from Aaditya Jeph (Grade V), Monish Mundra (Grade VI), and Chirayu Bhandari (Grade X), who secured Gold medals, while Ujjwal Sharma (Grade IX) earned a Silver medal. In International English Olympiad (IEO), 16 students participated, winning 6 Gold, 7 Silver, and 3 Bronze medals. Shivam Vijayvargiya (Grade VII), Ruchika Somani (Grade XII), and Krishanapal Rathore (Grade XII) qualified for Level 2. These achievements reflect the students' dedication and excellence across multiple domains.

In International Social Science Olympiad (ISSO) 2024, students showcased their knowledge of History, Geography, Civics, and Economics. Darsh Agrawal (Grade X) achieved the highest score of 68.06%, securing a Gold Medal, along with Aarav Agarwal (Grade VII) and Ayush Kumar (Grade IX), who also earned a Gold medal each. 



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CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATION










Drawing and Painting Competition on Maha Kumbh Mela 2025
