

board designs.



Board Result Declaration

Birla Public School. Kishangarh achieved a 100% pass rate in both Class X and Class XII Board Examinations for the 2023-24 academic session. In Class X, Aryan Laddha secured the top position with a score of 96.2%, followed by Kaushal Bishnoi (94%), Manas Hemrajani (93.2%), Milind Garg (93.2%), Vansh Verma (93.2%), and Aditya Mishra (91.8%). In Class XII, Nilisha Kumar achieved the highest score of 95.6% with 100 in Psychology and History followed by Rishi Sharma (95.4%) with 100 in Commerce, Gaurang Jajoo (94.5%), Anuj Agarwal (92.4%), Goutam Jatt (92%) with 100 in Psychology, Arya Agarwal (92%), Harshita Sherawat (91.4%) with 100 in Psychology, Ifra Jahan (91.2%), and Dhaval Jain (90.6%). A soldier I was, a soldier I'll be, Though gone from earth, my soul's aflame, Forever guarding India's name.


