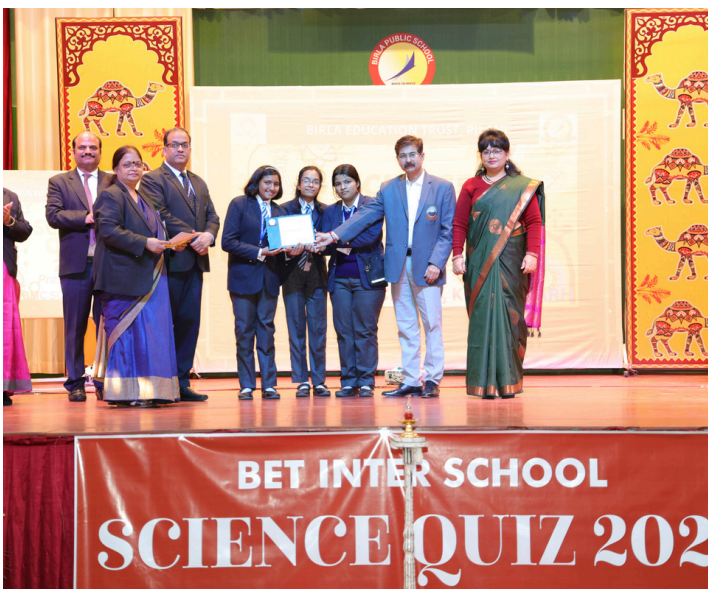
# Career Counselling & Motivational Session

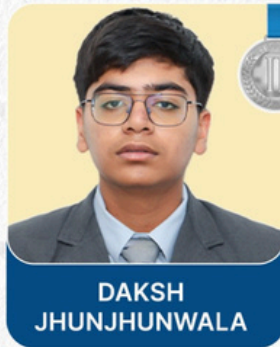

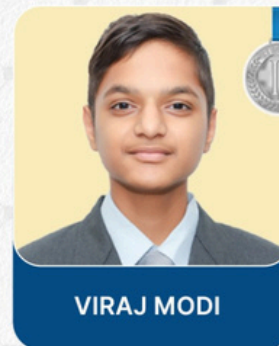

## Online Webinars

### Webinar: “Burnout to Balance”

Ms. Bably Sinha, School Counsellor and Activity Coordinator, attended a webinar titled “Burnout to Balance” on 7 November 2025, conducted by NELTAS. The session emphasized the importance of balancing work and personal life, taking short breaks, pursuing hobbies, and prioritising self-care to prevent burnout and sustain overall well-being and productivity.

### Online Training on Celebrating Specific Learning Disabilities

Three faculty members attended a 5-day online training on Celebrating Specific Learning Disabilities in Inclusive Classroom organised by NCERT, which concluded with a certification examination. The training enhanced their understanding of learning difficulties and equipped them with strategies to identify and support students with dyslexia more effectively.

### CBSE Webinar on Two Exam System

A webinar conducted by CBSE on the Two Exam System was attended by the Principal and faculty of Birla Public School, Kishangarh on 20 November 2025. The session provided important updates and clarifications on the implementation and structure of the proposed examination system.

### AI Masterclass

Around 42 students from Classes VIII to XII participated in a 3-day online AI Masterclass titled “Unlocking the Power of AI”, held from 24 to 26 November 2025. The sessions were hosted by Saint Louis University in collaboration with Experience 4Excelerate. The programme provided students with valuable exposure to emerging AI concepts and strengthened their understanding of future-ready technological skills.



## Online Competitions

### International French Competition

The International French Competition in collaboration with Prayatna Educational Society was held on 8 November 2025 at Birla Public School, Kishangarh. 75 students from Grades VI to X appeared for the examination.

### Aryabhata Ganit Challenge Stage II

The Aryabhata Ganit Challenge (AGC) – Stage 2 was conducted online on 10 November 2025 with a duration of one hour. Three students from Grade X qualified for Stage 2 represented school at the national level.

### Logiqids Aptitude Test

Students from Classes V to IX participated in the Logiqids Aptitude Test on 21st-century skills on 12 November 2025. As part of their preparation, the students completed a four-month training programme and solved 25 structured worksheets. This programme was an initiative undertaken in collaboration with IIT Bombay. Students who qualify will proceed to the second and final round.

### CBSE Heritage Quiz

Birla Public School, Kishangarh participated in the CBSE Heritage online Quiz on 13 November 2025. Three students—Bhavya Rawat (IX), Ayush Kumar (X), and Chirayu Bhandari (XI)—represented the school.

### SAFAL Assessments

The SAFAL assessments for Classes VI and IX were conducted smoothly in November 2025. The assessments in Language, Science, and Mathematics were held on 10 November, 12 November, 17 November, and 24 November 2025. All examinations were administered in an orderly manner with full student participation.



## Some Activities

### **Discussion by Prayoga Institute of Education Research**

Two facilitators from Birla Public School, Kishangarh joined a focused group discussion facilitated by the Prayoga Institute of Education Research, along with representatives from various schools across Rajasthan. The dialogue revolved around current teaching–learning practices and reflected on the crucial role of evidence-based research and data in refining and systemising these practices.

### **Inter House MIT App Making Competition**

The Inter-House MIT App Making Competition was successfully conducted on 22 November 2025 in the Senior ICT Lab. The event aimed to enhance students’ problem-solving skills, creativity, and digital innovation using MIT App Inventor, a visual programming tool developed by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) that allows learners to create mobile applications without prior coding knowledge.

The competition was organised in two categories—Junior (Classes 6–8) and Senior (Classes 9–11)—to encourage participation across different age groups. Students actively engaged in designing functional app prototypes, showcasing originality and technical understanding.

### **Future Tech Olympiad (IBM Skilled)**

The Future Tech Olympiad (IBM Skilled), conducted by the 1M1B Foundation in collaboration with CBSE and IBM, was held on 28 November 2025 at 6:45 PM. The Olympiad is designed to assess students’ understanding of emerging technologies such as AI, data science, cybersecurity, and digital literacy, and to encourage young “creators of future technology.” A total of 58 students from Classes VII to XII appeared for the examination.



## Some Activities

### Participation in Obliviate 2025

Master Ayushman Rastogi (Grade V) participated in Obliviate 2025, an online inter-school creative literary event organised by Jayshree Periwal School, Jaipur, on 26 November 2025. Participants were required to introduce a new character into the Harry Potter universe and explain its connection with Harry.

Ayushman confidently presented his character within the allotted two minutes and created a related sketch during the 40-minute illustration round. His performance showcased creativity, imagination, and strong storytelling ability.

### Inter-BET U-19 Boys Basketball Tournament

Birla Public School, Kishangarh's U-19 Boys Basketball Team secured the 2nd position in the Inter-BET Basketball Tournament held at Birla Public School, Pilani, from 28 to 29 November 2025. The team displayed strong coordination, determination, and sportsmanship throughout the competition.

### Counselling Session for Grades V to IX

...A series of counselling sessions on 'Avoiding Abusive Language' were conducted from 18 November 2025 onwards for classes V – IX. Through interactive presentations and real-life examples, students learned the impact of hurtful words and they were encouraged to use polite expressions, stay calm during conflicts, and avoid impulsive reactions. The activity "Words We Choose" helped them replace negative words with positive ones. All sessions ended with a pledge to use respectful language. This is an ongoing programme that will continue throughout the year.

## Jungle lunch

A Jungle Lunch was organised on 14 December 2025, during which students relished a variety of traditional Rajasthani delicacies amidst the serene natural surroundings near the temple of Birla Public School, Kishangarh. The experience in the natural habitat provided students with an opportunity to connect with nature while enjoying local cuisine, making the event both refreshing and memorable.



## Annual Day and Annual Prize Giving Ceremony

Birla Public School, Kishangarh celebrated its 12th Annual Day on 22 December 2025 on the theme “Ramayana – Unplugged.” The function was graced by Air Commodore S. K. Anand as the Chief Guest and Maj. Gen. S. S. Nair as the Guest of Honour.

The programme commenced with an Art and Craft Exhibition, where students presented and explained exhibits based on Hindu mythology, linking the theme Ramayana with its relevance in the modern context. This was followed by an impressive Equestrian Show and Martial Arts display, showcasing students’ horse-riding skills, discipline, and physical prowess, harmonised by the melodious performance of the school band.

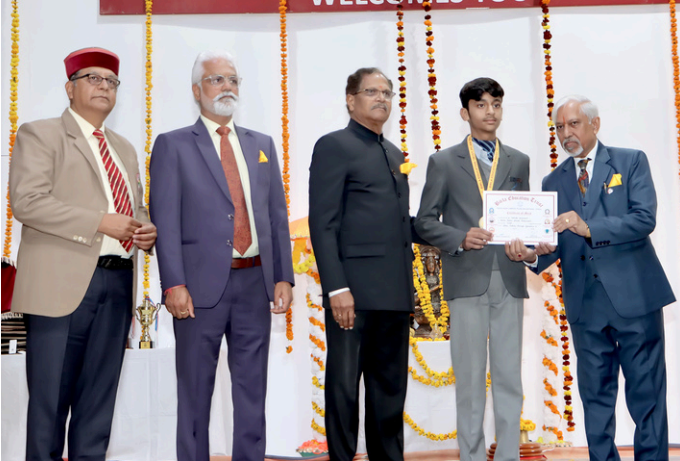

“If this reaches anyone, tell my daughter I kept the light on as long as I could.”

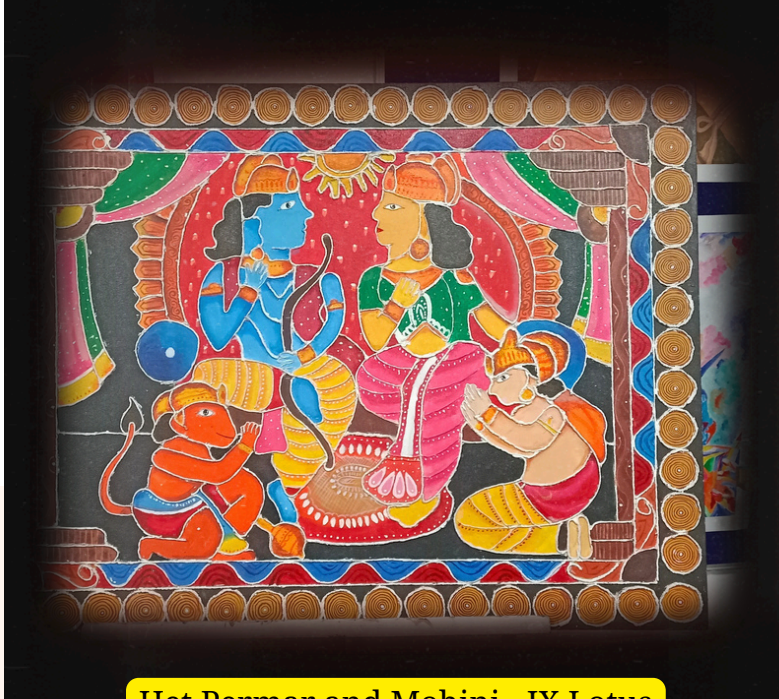
Meera closed the book quietly.

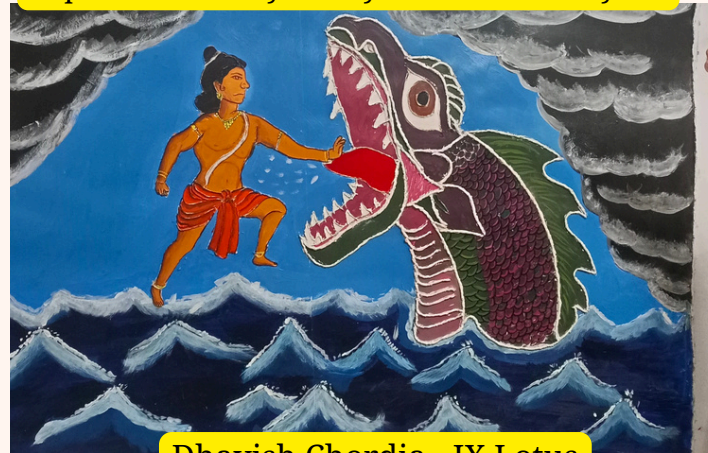

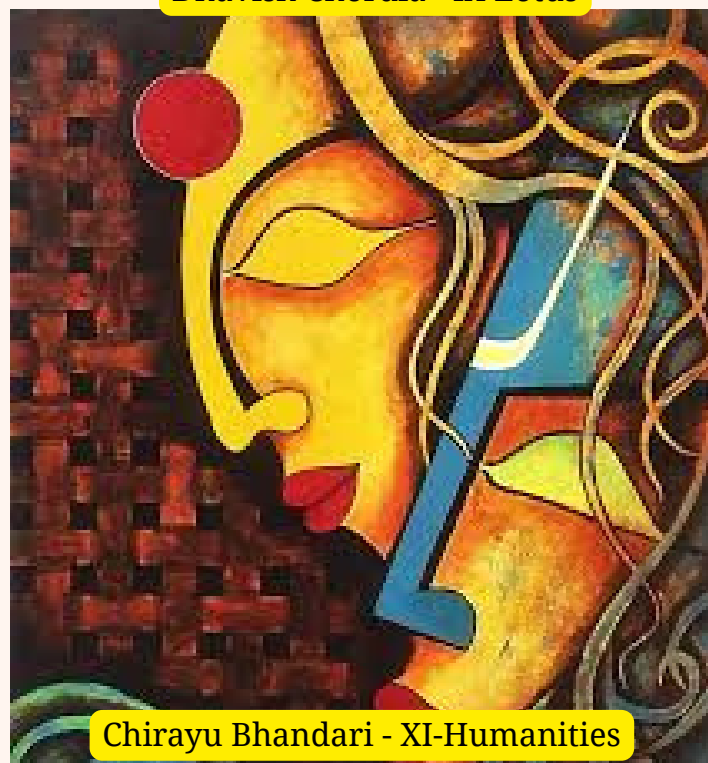
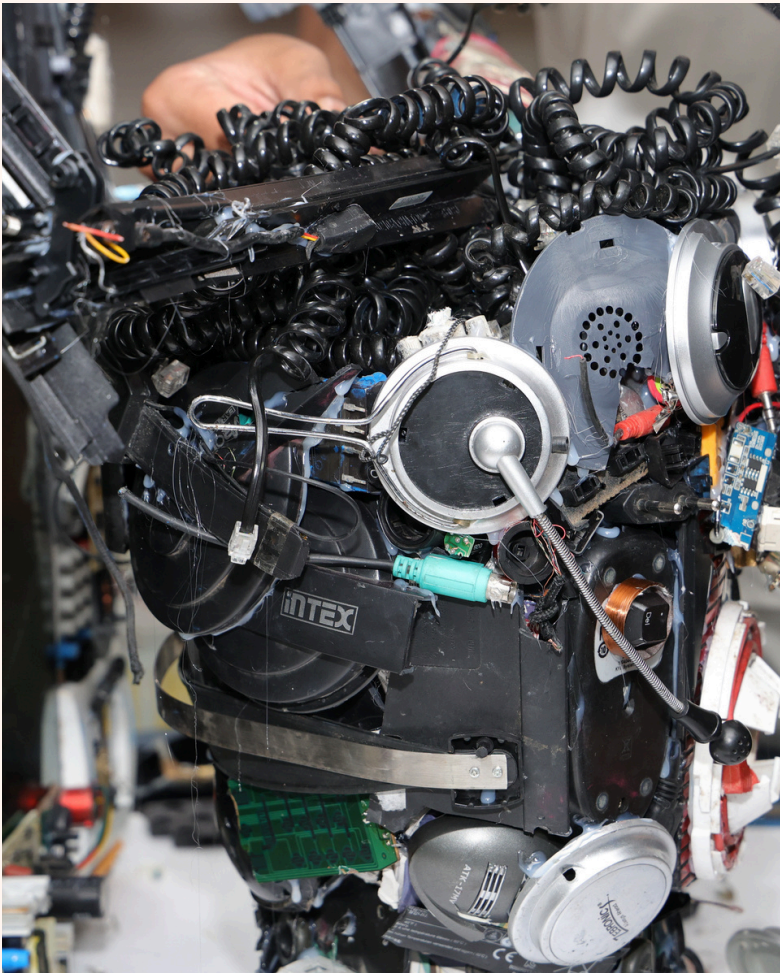
