ANAHAD - BEYOND THE SKY

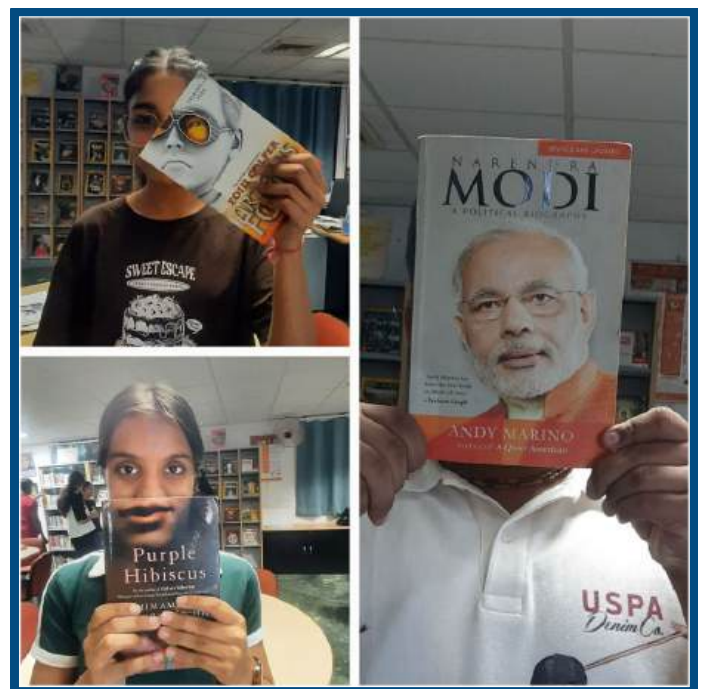

"It's the stone you carried." We didn't fix it. We made it the center of a circle. Others added their stones of missing, of waitings. The circle became a place to remember no one walks alone. Later, I saw him far down the road. His arms were full of new stones. He wasn't laying them for himself. He was filling the gaps of others.

The road still breaks. We mend it anyway because every mended place says: someone stayed long enough to care. And sometimes, that's the only bridge a heart needs.

The journey towards sustainability starts today—and it starts with each one of us.



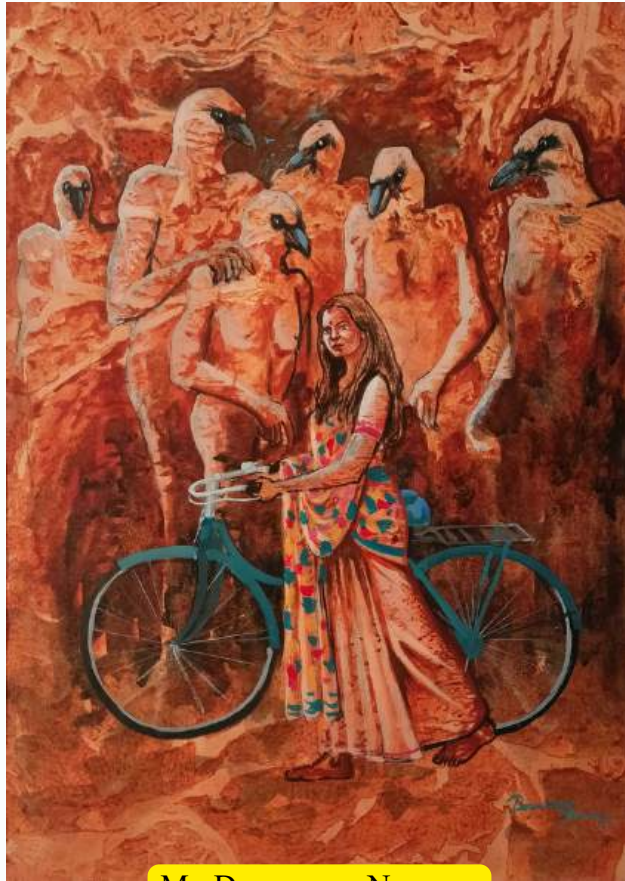
